STATISTICS OF THE 46TH KARLOVY VARY IFF 2011

The 46th Karlovy Vary IFF 2011 was attended by **12 033 accredited visitors**. Of that number **10 266** had Festival Passes (up from 9 424 in 2010), 310 were filmmakers, 814 film professionals, and 649 journalists.

126 302 tickets were sold for 413 film screenings. A total of 199 films were shown: 165 feature films (151 full-length and 14 short) and 34 documentary films (26 full-length and 8 short). 21 films received their world premiere, while 25 had their international premiere and 16 their European premiere. There were 70 490 votes for the Právo Audience Award. 54 of the films screened were debuts. 172 screenings were personally presented by delegations of filmmakers.

FILM INDUSTRY AT THE 46TH KARLOVY VARY IFF 2011

813 film buyers, sellers, distributors, film festival programmers, representatives of film institutions, and other industry professionals were accredited for the 46th Karlovy Vary IFF. 384 accredited film professionals came to the festival from abroad. 117 film buyers and distributors and 134 festival programmers chose from new films and Works in Progress. International sales agents could choose from a total of 61 films. 24 selected films (from a total of 50 entries) were presented in Works in Progress.

KARLOVY VARY ONLINE SCREENING ROOM ON CINANDO

In co-operation with Cinando.com, the Karlovy Vary IFF this year for the second time is offering buyers, distributors and other users of Cinando.com the opportunity to watch its competition films. The screening room went live on July 8th, 2011.
